

DE-WORMING SCHEDULES FOR FOALS & ADULT HORSES

FOALS:

4 – 6 Weeks:

1. Panacur paste for ascarids

Every two months after the initial worming

2. Strongid paste for general parasite control
3. Panacur paste for general parasite control

Fall, after first freeze

4. Ivermectin with praziquantel (Moxidectin) on foals 6 months and older for tapeworms and bots

Do not use moxidectin before 6 months of age, use Ivermectin for foals less than 6 months of age

5. Strongid paste for general parasite control

Winter

6. Panacur Power Pac (5 days of Panacur) for general control and removes encysted small strongyles other de-wormers cannot remove.

ADULT HORSES:

Approximately 5 times per year:

Ivermectin

Panacur

Strongid

Ivermectin with praziquantel for tapeworms and bots

Panacur Power Pac for removal of all small encysted strongyles
